

POLICY RESOLUTION PR-12-06
TITLE: STREAMLINE PFC APPLICATION AND REPORTING PROCESSES

WHEREAS, the Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) application and reporting processes are too cumbersome and costly; and

WHEREAS, the application process can take more than nine months for an airport to gain approval to begin collecting PFCs, and

WHEREAS, the program would be more efficient if airports had more control over the process, as they do with airport rates and fees; and

WHEREAS, the program should not require consultation with the airlines as a condition for imposing PFCs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the FAA and Congress streamline the PFC application process by implementing at the least the following:

- Computerization of all aspects of application process, including airline and FAA correspondence, notification and approval requirements,
- Electronic filing of quarterly PFC reports, and
- Establishment of a PFC national database to post information.
